Engine Starting Instructions

- Engine key is stowed on the key rack above port settee
- Ensure engine water intake is open. This is located under the sink in the head. It is the valve under the black strainer. Open is when the valve handle is parallel to the hose.
- Ensure transmission is in neutral
- Nudge throttle lever to approximately 1 / 4 forward
- Turn Key one click. Fuel gauge and voltmeter will activate.
- Then continue to turn Key against spring. This activates the glow plugs. Hold for 10 seconds.
- Continue to hold the key in “Glow” position and press the Start Button.
- Hold Start Button and Key until engine starts then release both.
- Do not crank for more than 10 seconds. If the engine doesn't start, release Start Button and Key
 - Check that the Engine Stop Cable is fully pushed in, nudge the throttle forward slightly and repeat starting process.
- Once the engine has started, check the port stern to ensure water is coming from the exhaust. If not, shut down engine immediately.
- Tachometer will show 0 rpm until the engine has been running for approx 45 seconds. Then set to high idle at approx 1000 rpm.
- Reduce RPM to low idle (600 – 800 RPM) before shifting into gear

Good Idea

Engine Shutdown Instructions

- Pull throttle lever back to low idle – approx 600 - 800 rpm
- Pull Engine Stop Cable up.
- Once engine has stopped, turn the key off.

Do not turn the key off to try to stop the engine

- The engine will not stop, and
- Damage to the electrical charging system may result
